Job Summary:

The Speech/Language Pathologist with a certificate of clinical competence shall possess the knowledge and skills to:

- Evaluate a student's communication skills according to standard tools and development guidelines.
- Develop appropriate communication goals/objectives for student's I.E.P.
- Participate in I.E.P. team planning, development and implementation.
- Keep accurate data/notes
- Provide training/instruction regarding communication skills to parents/staff.

- Required: Master's degree with a major in communication disorders or speech language pathology.
